

Airplane Noise Advisory Committee
July 7, 2025
Cronin Conference Room, Town Hall

Present: Committee members Raj Pathak, David Godine, Katie Conlon and Josh Thompson

1. The meeting began at 6:01 p.m.
2. Elizabeth Kaczmarek of 358 Central Avenue addressed the Committee during Public Comment. She has noticed a reduction in airplane noise during the last three months and asked the Committee if the FAA has changed the flight paths. Mr. Godine advised that no changes to flight paths have yet been instituted and answered questions.
3. The Committee followed up its March discussion of goals and objectives. Mr. Godine has spoken with a resident who is interested in applying to the Select Board for appointment to the Committee. Mr. Thompson suggested various courses of action for the Town to consider, including litigation and Congressional outreach. Mr. Pathak, Mr. Godine and Ms. Conlon reviewed some of Milton's recent activity on these fronts. The Committee discussed the need for the Select Board and the town's next representative to the Massport Community Advisory Committee (MCAC) to pursue testing and implementation of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's recommendations for the Runway 4R arrival path. Other topics discussed included the possibility of advertising the Committee's vacancy in the Milton Times or via social media, educating new residents about how to file noise complaints, and hosting informational tables at social events such as Celebrate Milton. The Chair will follow up again with the Town Administrator and the Chair of the Select Board about an appointment of a new MCAC representative.
4. The Committee will meet on August 25 at 6:00 p.m.
5. At 6:47 p.m., on a motion made by Mr. Pathak and seconded by Mr. Thompson, the Committee voted 4-0 by roll call to adjourn.
