Re: Tree Removal at 193 Central Avenue

Dear Mr. Czerwienski,

After reviewing the existing trees on site at 193 Central Avenue with a certified arborist, we would like to recommend the following:

- Remove the existing oak tree that is currently leaning over Central Avenue
- Remove the adjacent oak tree that is dead and showing decay fungus on the trunk
- Prune the large oak tree on Columbine Road to allow for the construction of the new building
- Prune the existing smaller oak on Columbine to remove any dead limbs or trunks
- Remove the Norway maple on Columbine that is currently being killed by its own girdling
- Remove the large pine in the back corner of the property that is directly adjacent to the new building and in danger of falling due to the root system being cut back to allow for the new building foundation to be installed

If the above recommendations are accepted, we propose to plant 4 - 6 new trees on the property to replace the removal of the 4 trees as advised. The species and location will be determined by the landscape architect and proposed to the town prior to planting.

Attached is the proposal from our arborist, inclusive of their recommendations.
