The competition for the \$4.95 million of available funding was intense, with 127 applications totaling almost \$13.8 million. Although we were not able to provide a grant to your community this year, we anticipate offering this grant program again in fiscal year 2026. All eligible communities will be notified directly when the fiscal year 2026 application phase opens. We thank you for taking the time to apply for this grant program.
