

SPECIAL TOWN ELECTION – NOVEMBER 4, 2025 - EARLY VOTE BY MAIL APPLICATIONS

The Office of the Town Clerk is accepting vote-by-mail applications for the November 4th Special Town Election to Fill a Vacancy on the Select Board. Vote-by-mail applications must be completed for each election unless you have already applied for the year (2025).

Milton registered voters can request a vote by mail ballot by using any of the following methods:

- **Online:** Apply through the Massachusetts Mail-in Ballot Application System (<https://www.sec.state.ma.us/MailInRequestWeb/MailInBallot.aspx>)
- **Mail, Email, Fax, or In-Person:** Download the vote-by-mail application from the Town Clerk's website, sign it (typed signatures are not accepted), and submit via: mail or in person

- **Email:** Send a scanned signed image of the application to: townclerk@miltonma.gov and/or sgalvin@miltonma.gov. Typed signatures on applications cannot be accepted
- **Fax** to 617-696-6995

Alternatively, if unable to locate an official form, a signed, written request indicating your name registration address, and desired mailing address for the ballot is acceptable.

When the voter receives the vote-by-mail ballot in the mail, the voter should mark the ballot, complete and sign the gold affidavit envelope and place marked ballot inside, as soon as possible. The signed affidavit envelope with the completed ballot sealed inside must be returned (sealed in the white envelope) to the Office of the Town Clerk. Voted mail-in ballots may not be brought directly to precinct polling places. Voted ballots may be returned by mail or dropped off by the voter or a family member at the Town Clerk's Office before the polls close. Ballots received after the polls close cannot be counted. The deadline to request a vote by mail ballot for the Special Town Election is October 28, 2025. Please file your request early to allow time for your ballot to be mailed to you and for you to return your voted ballot so it reaches the Office of the Town Clerk by the close of polls to be counted.
